3. The purpose and vision of the event

- The Send is an international Christian youth event and movement, the aim of which is
 to inspire young people to live missionally in everyday life, at schools, at work, and
 among the poorest and unreached in the world.
- The key message of the event is: turn to Jesus with all your heart and follow him with all your life.

- The event has three "scenes", with the following themes
 - I. Personal spiritual awakening
 - II. A call to live as witness of Jesus

The speakers and artists of the event are men and women of different ages from Finland and abroad known personally by the organizers. Some of them are young Finns serving their own generation. In addition, the program includes young people's testimonies about what God is doing in Finland today.

 All speeches are interpreted on the stage into Finnish or English. Sign language is also available.

Speakers:

- Andy Byrd* works in the Unites States in the leadership team of YWAM Kona. His
 call is to inspire, invite and lead young people to fulfill Jesus' Great Commission.
- Francis Chan is an American, internationally known Bible teacher and author. The
 focus of his teaching is on God's greatness and love and wholehearted commitment
 to Jesus.
- Teo Hayashi* is a Brazilian founder of the Dunamis movement and the lead-pastor in Monte Siao Church in Sao Paulo. His dream is to see university students being saved and trained to fulfill Jesus' Great Commission.
- Peter Louis is the founder of Braveheart Ministries and pastor in the UPPERROOM church. He aims to strengthen the faith of Christians and the global church in the strength and depth of the gospel.
- Rick Warren* is a pastor, missions advocate and author. He is known by the
 bestseller books The Purpose Driven Church and The Purpose Driven Life, which
 have also been published in Finnish. In 2004 and 2006 Time and Newsweek
 nominated him as one of the most influential leaders both in the US and globally.
 Today he works as the leader of the Finishing the Task missions network.
- Luke Greenwood serves as the European Director for Steiger, and is dedicated to reaching the Global Youth Culture for Jesus.
- Andreas Nordli leads YWAM Norway and is part of the international Send board.
 He led The Send Oslo in 2022.
- Joona Salo* is the youth pastor and assistant director of Tampere Pentecostal Church. He dreams of a Holy Spirit empowered church where every newcomer finds his or her place and grows as a full hearted Jesus' follower.
- Henri Hermunen* is the director of YWAM Finland and works as pastor in the Syke Church in Tampere. He leads The Send movement and mobilizes the new generation to fulfill the Great Commandment.
- Päivikki Pitkänen leads Go Out outreach in Tampere Pentecostal Church and gives evangelism training in the national Go Out ministry.

- Sanna Stolberg leads the Carry the Love tour in cooperation with the Circuit Riders
 movement.
- Teresa Niikko leads a Send tour team, which has toured round Finland since August 2024.

Worship leaders:

6. Background and history

- The Send was organized as a single event in the United States in 2019. It gave birth to the Send movement, which by now has spread to ten countries: Armenia, Brazil, Finland, the Netherlands, New Zealand, Norway, the Philippines, South Africa, the United Kingdom, the United States
- In Brazil The Send 2020 filled three stadiums (150 000 participants) simultaneously.
- In Norway The Send 2022 was the biggest youth event in the country in 40 years (9300 participants).
- In Finland the event is now arranged for the first time.

7. Why The Send now?

- New spiritual awakening among young people is happening in Finland and in different parts of Europe.
- Young people are seeking purpose and connection, and are interested in Jesus Christ.
- The Send encourages participants to respond to this need.

8. Main organizers and finances

- In Finland The Send is organized by YWAM Finland in cooperation with the Pentecostal World Conference Go & Make!. It is entirely organized by the Finns.
- The event is financially independent, in other words Finnish organizers are responsible for the finances of the event, and no money is transferred abroad. The Send finances use a dedicated account in the financial management of the Pentecostal Church.
